OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS AND PISTOL SAFETY

- 1. Push magazine latch back and withdraw magazine from frame.
- Insert cartridges under magazine lips then insert back in frame after magazine is loaded.
- Pull back the slide and release it, cartridge is then fed into the chamber. Gun is then cocked and ready to fire. If gun is not to be fired be sure to put pistol on safe. Cocking indicator at rear of slide will be out if pistol is cocked.
- (a) Safety is on left hand side of pistol. To place safe on, push safety connector up.
 - (b) Magazine safety will not allow pistol to be shot with magazine out.
 - (c) Cocking indicator will indicate if pistol is cocked.

PISTOL DISASSEMBLY

- 1. Make sure pistol is not cocked or loaded.
- Pull back slide until safety connector can catch in forward slot on slide.
- Rotate barrel counter clockwise one quarter turn. Release safety and hold onto slide. Slide should come off easily, if not, gently pull slide forward until slide if off frame.

The gun is stainless steel, but in order to insure against tarnishing or pitting caused by individual salt and acids within the human body it is recommended that the pistol be occasionally lubricated with any well-known oun oil or lubricant.

NOTE: For the protection of others as well as yourself, always use extreme care in the handling of this pistol as well as any other firearm. This pistol is classified as a firearm, and should be handled as such.
