INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR F.I.E. MODEL A27 PISTOL

The A27 pistol has a thumb safety and magazine safety. When the thumb safety is in the "safe" position with the letter "S" showing, the action of the pistol is literally frozen and the gun cannot be fired....the magazine safety is a built-in safety device which makes it impossible to fire the pistol if the magazine is not in place.

Do not clean your A27 with strong chemicals,,,,a bristle brush and a good quality light gun oil and a clean soft cloth are all that you need to routinely maintain your pistol.


To disassemble your pistol the following steps should be followed:

- 1. Remove the magazine and inspect the pistol to make sure that the chamber is empty.
- 2. Move the thumb safety into safe position. Draw the slide to the rear. The hook on the thumb safety will engage the notch on the side of the slide. The slide will remain open.
- 3. Hold the pistol in the left hand and turn the barrel ½ turn to the right. This will loosen the barrel from the frame. Draw the barrel forward and turn it ½ turn to the left. Remove the barrel from the slide.
- 4. Release the thumb safety and move the slide forward until it is free from the frame.

The above four steps constitute all the disassembly necessary in order to clean, oil and maintain your F.I.E. A27 pistol.

When disassembling your pistol, remember that it is a precision piece of equipment and no parts should ever be forced. We further recommend that when you disassemble your gun, place the pieces in sequence on a table in front of you and lay the pieces out from left to right. This will simplify reassembling of your pistol.

All of the guns that we build or import are guaranteed to be free from defects in materials or work manship for one year after you, the owner, has purchased the gun from an authorized licensed dealer.

During this period of one year you are guaranteed repair or replacement (at our option) without charge for parts or labor but excluding transportation to and from our repair facilities. In case of replacement the guarantee period continues from the original date of purchase.

This guarantee is void on transfer of ownership. It is also voided if the gun has been modified, misused, abused, altered in any way, repaired without our authorization or used with reloaded or non standard ammunition. No warranty is implied against normal wear and tear.

Failure to send us your registration card cancels out the warranty. Our warranty of merchantability and fitness applies only for the effective period of the expressed warranty.
