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
60-/100-Round High-Capacity Magazine

Disassembly:

- 1. Use punch or screwdriver to pry up floor plate and slide rearward to remove. (Illustration 1)
- 2. Remove divider/spring guide through bottom opening. (See illustration 2 for this and remaining steps)
- Remove bottom spring and spring cup. Note: Depress and gently rock bottom spring to clear floor-plate tabs on magazine body to avoid damaging plating on spring.
- 4. Remove top spring and four-column follower.
- 5. Remove two-column follower spring and two-column follower.

Assembly:

- Invert and insert the divider/spring guide in through the top of the magazine body so its
 curvature aligns with the curvature of the magazine body. Note: Divider/spring guide follower
 is purposely being inserted upside-down in order to align springs and followers during assembly process.
- Insert the two-column follower and its attached spring into magazine body and align slot in two-column follower with inverted divider/spring guide.
- 3. Install four-column-follower top spring to the cylindrical portion of the four-column follower.
- Insert four-column follower with attached top spring into magazine body and align with divider/spring guide.
- Attach four-column-follower bottom spring to the spring cup. Note: Spring must be fully seated against lip of spring cup.
- 6. Insert spring cup and bottom spring into magazine body. Note: Cup must be inserted at 45-degree angle between floor-plate tabs at bottom of magazine. Must depress each spring coil and move in side-to-side motion to avoid contact with the tabs until the bottom spring is fully installed into magazine body.
- 7. Remove the inverted divider/spring guide from the opening at the top.
- Insert divider/spring guide, through bottom opening of magazine, into the center of the bottom spring until fully seated.
- 9. Press divider/spring guide until floor plate has room to be re-inserted.
- 10. Slide floor plate until it's fully engaged with the magazine body. Note: Ensure gray spring guide base is visible through hole in floor plate.
