Your Puma will accept cartridges indicated beside "CALIBERS" on the chart above. Also, every rifle/carbine has the caliber stamped on the barrel. The use of any other ammunition that is not indicated, as well as reloaded ammo, is extremely dangerous and could result in damage or injury to the shooter and people nearby.

1) LOADING THROUGH LOADING GATE With the bullet of each cartridge, press the spring cover inward and push the cartridges forward nearly to end of spring cover, pushing the last one fully forward until the cover

2) LOADING THROUGH MAG TUBE

Pull out inside magazine tube until the loading port is clear and place the cartridges into the magazine. Replace the tube in its position.

(Models PUM-60024, PUM-60025, PUM-60026, PUM-60030, PUM-60031 and PUM-60032 only)

OPERATING

Swing the finger-lever forward then back. The gun is now loaded and cocked. For safe carrying, let the hammer carefully down to half-cock by placing thumb on hammer and exerting pressure on trigger sufficient to release full-cock engagement. Then IMME-DIATELY remove finger from trigger. Permit hammer to move forward under control of thumb to half-cock position. To fire, draw the hammer back to full-cock.

The ejection of the spent case and ready replacement with a fresh cartridge is done automatically on a subsequent operation of the finger lever.

WARNING

The use of Full Metal Jacketed Bullets in rifles with tubular magazines is an unsafe practice. Cartridges in a magazine tube are aligned in a manner that permits the bullet point to be in direct contact with the primer of the abutting cartridge; therefore, recoil inertia may be sufficient to set off the cartridges in the magazine.DO NOT, UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES, USE AMMUNITION HAVING FULL METAL JACKETED BULLETS.

BASIC RULES OF FIREARM SAFETY

- Learn the mechanical and handling characteristics of the firearm you are using.
- Always keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction, finger off the trigger.
- Firearms should be unloaded and securely stored when not in use. Be sure the barrel is clear of obstruction before using.

- Don't shoot at a hard surface or at water.
- Never transport a loaded firearm.
