Reduction sleeves with 7/24 external and Morse internal taper and incorporated screw

1 Scope

This International Standard specifies the dimensions of reduction sleeves with 7/24 external taper No. 30-40-45-50 and 60 and Morse internal taper No. 1 to 6 (Morse taper No. 4, 5 and 6 being either with positive drive, see Figure 2, or without positive drive, see Figure 1).

These sleeves permit driving of tools with Morse taper shanks with tapped holes with the aid of an internal screw. The form of this screw and its fixation in the sleeve are left to the manufacturer's discretion.

7/24 tapers are in accordance with ISO 297. Morse tapers are in accordance with ISO 296 and ISO 5413.

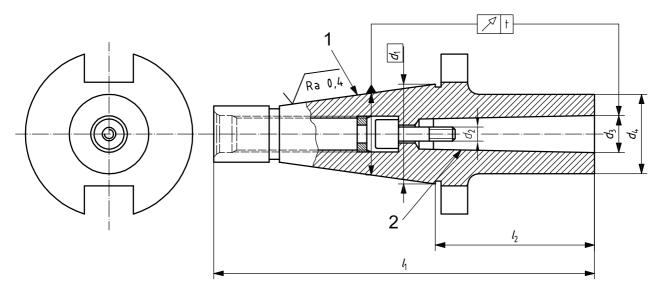
3 Dimensions

3.1 General

All dimensions and tolerances are given in millimetres. Tolerances not specified shall be of tolerance class "m" in accordance with ISO 2768-1:1989.

3.2 Reduction sleeves with 7/24 external taper shank type A and Morse internal taper No. 1 to 6

The dimensions of reduction sleeves with 7/24 external and Morse internal taper of type A are shown in Figure 1 and given in Table 1.



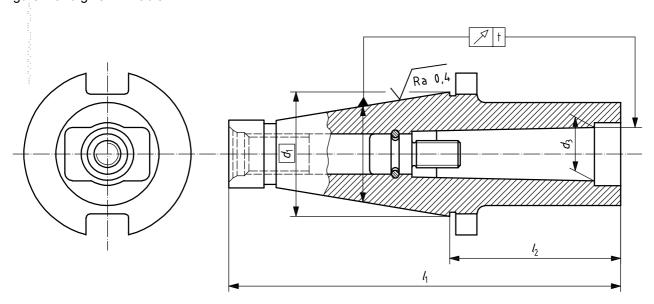
Key

4 Material

The material is left to the manufacturer's discretion but the tensile strength shall be at least 800 N/mm².

Hardness shall be 56 + 4HRC.

5 Designation

A reduction sleeve in conformance with this International Standard shall be designated as follows:

- a) Reduction sleeve;
- b) the reference to this International Standard, i.e., ISO 5415:2007;
- c) 7/24 external taper shank type A or B;
- d) 7/24 taper number;
- e) the letter x;
- f) Morse taper number.

EXAMPLE 1 A reduction sleeve with 7/24 external taper shank type A, No. 40 and Morse taper No. 4 is designated as follows:

Reduction sleeve ISO 5415 - A 40 x 4

EXAMPLE 2 A reduction sleeve with 7/24 external taper shank type B, No. 40 and Morse taper No. 4 is designated as follows:

Reduction sleeve ISO 5415 - B 40 x 4
