**ORDER GRANTING PETITIONER'S MOTION TO TEMPORARILY SEAL MOTION
TO COMPEL**

This matter is before the Court on Jane Doe #1 and Jane Doe #2's Motion to Temporarily Seal Their Motion to Compel Answers to Supplemental Requests for Admissions and Requests for Production (DE 347) ("Petitioner's Motion").

Petitioner's Motion of December 28, 2015 requests that the Motion to Compel (DE 348) "be placed under seal for ten days or until the Court has ruled on any motion by any non-party to seal the motion, whichever is longer." The Court has reviewed the contents of the motion and, in view of some of the assertions contained in the motion, the Court finds that the motion should remain sealed pending further order of the Court.

Accordingly, it is hereby **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that Petitioner's Motion (DE 347)
