The **passport card** is a credit-card size U.S. **passport** that, just like a **passport** book, is proof of U.S. citizenship and identity. It is more convenient and less expensive than a **passport** book, but can only be used to re-enter the United States at land border crossings and sea ports-of-entry from: Canada. Mexico.
The passport card cannot be used for international air travel.
