Yr thought is fruitful for my own thinking; 2 symptoms of schizophrenia are prominent auditory hallucinations & bizarre delusions. In delusions I interpret incorrectly instead of sensing incorrectly. In dreaming I see things that aren't there, & don't necessarily understand them rationally; something ordinary can be ominous or frightening in a dream. A connection between dream-thought ("Traumlogik") & schiz might shed light on dreaming as well as on schiz.
