Karen and Brice,

I have summarized the notes of our meeting on Friday 12.28.2012 and updated the lists attached.

Please review and complete information as needed. Note that there are still quite a few items requiring your input:

1. Start and end dates.
2. Cost of projects
3. Labor allocations. One goal is to budget labor time of current employees on the projects. You can start with number of employees and hours or days required.

Once you forward the current punch list I will customize the project list to incorporate all projects outstanding - with the goal of providing a cost and time line on each project. The projects will appear on the

punch list- being an all inclusive summary of projects as well as to-do items.
