Greetings Ken,

Thank you for the update and the advisement regarding the purple grass. We will advise JE that the grass is being moved inside tomorrow morning to dry out from the heavy rains. If they are drier to not risk loss, they can be sleeved and shrink wrapped, delivered to the Norma H by noon on Saturday 12/7, EDA on STT Monday, 12/9.

When you are ready, you can let us know about coming over to clear, etc. We will look for your update in the next few days on the status of the grass being dry enough to sail this weekend. I will also keep Chris updated for you.

Daphne,

Just spoke with the vendor- the grass is wet, and received more rain this a.m. I asked them to move them under cover, but they won't be able to do so until in the morning, as they have other product shipping out from their loading area in front of ours.

Since we lost alot of grasses when they shipped last time, I don't want a repeat. Sleeving them, then shrink wrapping them, will hold the moisture in and create a problem that I prefer to avoid.

Norma H received product until noon on Saturday, arriving STT Monday morning. If the plants are drier by then I prefer to go that route rather than replacing plants a third time.
