Janine di Giovanni suggested through a mutual friend that I contact you about our difficulties in recovering the body of my colleague Marie Colvin from Homs.

The intensity of shelling in the Baba Amr area and the distrust felt by the Free Syrian Army for the Red Crescent and ICRC make it hard for us to see how an arrangement can be reached for a handover of Marie's remains. The French ambassador in Damascus is taking the diplomatic lead because Marie died with Remi Ochlik, a French citizen, but progress is erratic. Any advice on a way forward would be warmly appreciated.
