of our undercover investigations of two PetSmart stores, where we documented that more than 100 small animals-including hamsters, domestic rats, lizards, chinchillas, and birds-were deprived of effective veterinary care and were slowly dying, out of customers' sight. Our undercover investigation of Mepkin Abbey, a monastery in South Carolina that runs an egg factory farm where hens live in cramped battery cages, led the abbey to announce a phaseout of its egg operation. We were victorious in aiding in the prosecution and conviction of many animal abusers, including a notorious Arkansas animal hoarder; a New York cow killer who set fire to a barn, killing more than 70 cows; and a Texas pseudo-sanctuary owner who was selling wild and exotic animals. We succeeded in getting both a lawsuit by the Australian Wool Innovation and a lawsuit by a Michigan chinchilla fur farmer dismissed. We funded a highly successful spay/neuter program that made surgeries available at little to no cost to disadvantaged animal guardians, preventing thousands of unwanted litters and providing relief to overburdened, government-run animal control offices and local animal shelters.
