COMMENCING A PROCEEDING
FOR A PRIVATE INFORMATION UNDER
THE CRIMINAL CODE OF CANADA

As a citizen, you have the right to appear before a Justice of the Peace to lay charges against another person by swearing to an Information. A Justice of the Peace must receive the Information if it meets the statutory provisions of the Criminal Code of Canada.

Upon your swearing an oath to the Information outlining the charge(s), The Criminal Code of Canada requires that the Justice of the Peace refer the matter to a Provincial Court Judge or a designated Justice of the Peace to consider whether to issue a summons or warrant to bring the person charged before the court.

By law, the Provincial court Judge or designated Justice of the Peace may only issue a summons or warrant if they have heard and considered the allegations of the informant and evidence of witnesses. Also the Provincial Court Judge or designated Justice of the Peace must be satisfied that the Attorney General has received a copy of the Information and has been given reasonable notice of the hearing and an opportunity to attend to cross-examine and call witnesses and present any relevant evidence at the hearing. The hearing will not occur at the time the Information is sworn.

If the Provincial Court Judge or designated Justice of the Peace decides there are grounds to do so, a summons or, more rarely, an arrest warrant, may be issued for the accused person to compel him or her to attend in court to answer to the charge(s). ***The Provincial Court Judge or designated Justice of the Peace is not required to issue any form of process to bring someone to court if they are not satisfied the allegations set forth in the evidence presented at the hearing support the charge(s).***

A Provincial Court Judge or Justice of the Peace is strictly prohibited from giving any advice about what charges to lay nor can they give you any other type of legal advice, opinion or guidance. If you are seeking a legal opinion or require guidance about this process, or the situation has caused to consider this process, you should seek advice from a lawyer or legal clinic.

I will say: Court 1 - Prime Minister Justin Trudeau did knowingly and willfully attempt to obstruct, pervert or defeat the course of justice contrary to Section 139(2) of the Criminal Code of Canada - Obstructing justice - by interfering with Attorney General Jody Wilson-Raybould decision to prosecute the company known as SNC-Lavalin.

Court 2 - Prime Minister Justin Trudeau instructed his staff, including Mathieu Bouchard, Gerald Butts and Michael Wernick, to contact Jody Wilson-Raybould in order to pressure the Attorney General into not prosecuting SNC-Lavalin contrary to Section 465(1)(c) – Conspiracy to commit indictable offence.

Furthermore, Mr. Trudeau has publicly stated his intention was to prevent the prosecution of SNC-Lavalin in order to save jobs in Canada. While this may appear to be a noble reason, one cannot rob a bank in order to feed the poor. As such, Mr. Trudeau's public statement only demonstrates that he understood that his actions were designed to obstruct, pervert or defeat the prosecution of SNC-Lavalin.

Under Canadian Law and common law no one is above the law neither King nor Prime Minister.

The primary purpose of private prosecution in Canada is to allow private citizens to lay charge when the police and/or crown fail or refuse to do so.

Evidence that will be presented will include video and audio files and sworn testimony. Witnesses will be subpoenaed to appear at the pre-enquete.




