Chief The 120 years refer symbolically to the Frieze grade
of the First order, - and to the Revulsion of the
powers of the Pentagram, also to the 5 preparatory
examinations for this Grade.

It is written "His days shall be 120 years" and
120 divided by 5 yields 24 the number of hours
in a day, and of the Thrones of the Elders in
the Apocalypse. Further 120 equals the
number of the Ten Sephiroth multiplied by
that of the Zodiac, whose Key is the working of the
Spirit and the Four Elements, typified in the
Wand which I bear. 9

For the 3 months interval between the grades of
Practices and Philosophies are the Regimen of the
elements, and the 7 months interval between
the First and Second orders, symbolize the Regimen
of the Planets; while the Elements and the Planets
both work in the Zodiac, - so that 3 plus 7

multiplied by 12 yieldeth the number 120.



of the Rose and Cross hath existed from time
immemorial, and that its mystic Rites
were practised, and its hidden knowledge
communicated in the initiations of the various
races of antiquity - Egypt, Eleusis
Samothrace; Persia, Chaldea, and
India alike cherished these mysteries
and thus handed down to posterity the
Secret Wisdom of the Ancient ~~—~~ Ages.

Many were its temples, and among many
nations were they established; though in
process of time some lost the purity of their
primal Knowledge: howbeit the manner
of its introduction into medieval Europe
was thus: -

In 1398 was born the Chief and originator
of our Fraternity in Europe. He was of a
noble German family, but poor, and in
the fifth year of his age was placed in a
cloister where he learned both Greek and
Latin. While yet a youth he accompanied
a certain Brother P.A.L. on a pilgrimage to

the Holy Land; but the latter dying at Cyprus, he himself went on to Damascus. There was then in Arabia a Temple of our order which was called in the Hebrew tongue יְהוָה דָמָר Damcar, that is - "Blood of the Lamb".

Here he was duly initiated, and took the mystic title C.R.C.; - Christian Rosenkreuz or Christian Rose Cross.

He then so far improved his knowledge of the Arabian Tongue that in the following year he translated the Book M. into Latin, which he afterwards brought back with him to Europe.

After 3 years he went on into Egypt, where was another Temple of our Order; there he remained for a time still studying the mysteries of Nature. After this he travelled by sea to the city of Fessa or Fez where he was welcomed at the Temple of our order there established and he there obtained the knowledge and acquaintance of the habitants of the Elements, who revealed

unto him many of their secrets. Of the
Fraternity at F.E.I., he confessed that they
had not retained our Wisdom in its primal
purity, and that their Cabala was to
a certain extent altered to their religion
yet nevertheless he learned much there.

After a stay of 2 years he came into
Spain, where he endeavoured to reform
the errors of the learned according to the
pure Knowledge he had received, but it
was to them a laughing matter, and they
reviled and rejected him, even as the
prophets of old were rejected

Thus also was he treated by those of his
own and other nations, when he shewed
the errors that had crept into their religions.
So after 5 years residence in Germany, he
initiated 3 of his former monastic brethren
Frates G.W.; I.A.; and I.O. who had
more knowledge than many others at that
time; and by these 4 was made the foundation
of the Fraternity in Europe. These worked
and studied at the writings and other knowledge

which C.R.C had brought with him, and by them was some of the Magical Language transcribed; (which is that of the Elemental Tablets), and a dictionary thereof made; and the Rituals and part of the Books in were transcribed.

For the true order of R.C descendeth unto the depths and ascendeth even unto the Throne of God himself, and includeth ~~some~~ Archangels, Angels and Spirits.

These 4 fratres also erected a building to serve for the Temple and head quarters of their order and called it

Collegium ad Spiritum Sanctum or the College of the Holy Spirit

This being now finished, and the work of establishing the order extremely heavy, and because they devoted much time to the healing of those sick and possessed who resorted unto them, they initiated 4 others namely fratres R.C. the son of the deceased father's brother of C.R.C; B. a skilful artist; G.G. and T.D. who was to be Cancellarius.

all being Germans except I. A.
and now 8 in number. Their Agreement was:-

1. that none of them should profess any other
thing, than but to cure the sick, and that gratis.
2. That they should not be constrained to
wear any distinctive dress, but therein to
follow the custom of the country.
3. that every year on the day C. they
should meet at the C. S. S. or write the
cause of absence
4. every one should look for some worthy
person of either sex, who after his
decease might succeed him
5. the word R.C. to be their mark, seal
and character
6. The fraternity to remain secret 100 years.

Five of the brothers were to travel in different
countries, and two were to remain with
Christian Rosenkreutz.



Second. Ad. Frater I. O. was the first to die, and
that in England, where he had wrought
many wonderful cures. He was an expert
Cabalist as his book called H. witnesseth.
His death had been previously foretold him
by C. R.

But those who were later admitted, and
were of the First Order knew not when
Frater C. R. C. died, and save what they
learned from Frater A., the successor of
D. of the Second Order, and from their
library after his death, - knew little of the
earlier and higher members and of the Founda-
tion yet whether three of the Second Order were
admitted to the Wisdom of the Highest mount.
The discovery then, of the Vault of the Adepts
wherein that lightly illuminated Man of God
our father C. R. C. was buried; - occurred
as follows; -







In this Tablet was the head of a strong



Prepare the Vault as in Diagram. The Chief Adept lies in the Pastos upon his back to represent the body of C.R.C; he clothed in full regalia. On his breast is the complete symbol of the Rosy Cross suspended the Double Phoenix Collar. His arms are crossed upon the Breast, avoiding the line of the Rosy Cross symbol, his hands rest on his shoulders bearing on his left shoulder the Scourge and in his left the Crook; and behind them or under them is the book T. The hand of the Pastos is closed, and the Circular Q stands over it. The Two other Adepts are outside the Vault as before. The Eleven Tablets and the 4 Chemic Symbols are hung on the outside of the Door of the Vault, disposed in any convenient manner in front. On the Altar is the Cross bearing a Rose; a Cask of Water & a Dagger in front of it; and also an Iron Chain.

2d Adept — Associate Adepts minor - let the aspirant
be now admitted.

3d Adept — opens door of Room, and admits Card, who
bears the Wand and Cusa Amata of the Chief Adept: he
is placed in front of the Vault door, facing it.

5 Adept — Before the door of the Vault as symbolic guardians
of the threshold of entrance are the Elemental Tablets
and the Cherubic Emblems; even as before the mystical
gate of Eden stood the Watchful Kerubim and the
Sword of Flame. These Kerubic emblems be the
powers of the Angles of the Tablets. Observe that
the Circle represents the Four Angles bound together
in each Tablet through the operation of the All
pervading Spirit, while the Cross within forms with
its arms the Radii of the Wheel of Ezekiel's Vision;
and therefore in each instance are the Cross and
the Circle represented White in allusion to the
Immaculate Purity of the Divine Spirit. And,
inasmuch as we see not the Elements unmixed
but each bound together with each, so that in the
Air we recognise not only that which is subtle and
temperate, but also the qualities of Heat, Moisture
and Dryness - bound together in that all wandering

Element,- and further also that in Fire, Water
and Earth - we observe the same Mixture of Nature
Therefore unto each Kerubic emblem are bound the
Four Heads - yet counter changed with the Colour
of the Element wherein they operate; even as in
the Vision of Ezekiel each Kerub had Four Face
and Four Wings. Forget not therefore
that the Tablets and the Kerubim, are the
Guardians of the Vault of the Adepts; let
thy tongue keep silence on our mysteries, and
restrain even the thoughts of thy heart - lest a
Bird of the Air should carry the matter.

Third Adept.—Upon more closely examining the
Door of the Vault you will perceive
(even as Frater N. N. and those with him
did perceive) that beneath the CXX in
the Inscription were placed the characters $\text{+ } \times \times$
thus: POST ^{CXX} $\text{+ } \times \times$ ANNOS PATEBO
being equivalent to POST ANNOS LUX CRUCIS PATEBO
"I the Light of the Cross will disclose myself"
For the letters forming LUX are made from the
dismembered and conjoined angles of the Cross;

and 120 is the Quotient of the Numbers 1 to 5 multiplied by each other in regular progression which number 5 is symbolised in the Cross with 4 extremities and one central Point. +

1st Adept. on the morning following Frater N.N. and his companions forced open the door - Opens it Wide and there appeared to their sight a Vault of Seven sides and Seven Corners, every side was Five feet broad and eight feet high; even as the same is here faithfully represented before you. Second Adept enters and passes to Head of C.R.C and turning-faces Entrance: The Third adept places Aspirant on the North side and facing South: The Third himself stands on the South side facing Aspirant and altar

Although in this Vault the Sun shineth not, yet is it illuminated by the Rays of the Symbolic Rose of our Order, situated in the Center of the flat Heptagonal ceiling. In the midst of the Vault standeth a circular altar with these Devices and Inscriptions:-

AGR C ad Gloriam Rosae Crucis

ACRG Ad Crucis Rosae Gloriam - hoc unius
compendium unius nihil Sepulchrum
fecit - Unto the Glory of the Rosy
Cross. - I have constructed this Sepulchrum
for myself - as a compendium of the
Universal Trinity.

Within the next circle is written

- > Yehoshua nihil omnia = Jesus is all thing to me
In the center are Four Figures of the Kerubim
enclosed within circles - surrounded by the following
Four inscriptions - and each distinguished
by one of the letters of Tetragrammaton, thus
- 1) ⌂ Lion. Nequaquam Vacuum. Nowhere a void
 - 2) ⌃ Eagle. Libertas Evangelii. Liberty of the Gospel
 - 3) ⌁ Man. Dei gloria intacta.. Unclouded Glory of God
 - 4) ⌄ Ox. Legis Jugum Yoke of the Law.
- and in the midst of all is Shin, the Letter
of the Spirit, forming thus the Divine Name
Yehoshua, from the Tetragrammaton:
This is all brilliant and flashing, as also are
the Seven Sides of the Vault and the Heptagonal Pillars
and Floor - Therefore by God's grace having

come thus far - let us all kneel down
together and say: - All Kneel - joining Wands and emas
awake above the Pastos

Unto Thee - sole Wise - sole mighty - and sole eternal
one - be Praise and Glory for ever, who hast
permitted this aspirant who now kneeleth
before thee to penetrate thus far into the
Sanctuary of thy mysteries.

Not unto Us - but unto thy Name be the Glory!
Let the influence of thy Divine ones descend upon
his head, and teach him the value of self
sacrifice - so that he shrink not in the
hour of trial; but that thus his name may
be written on high, and that his genius may
stand in the presence of the Holy One; in that hour
when the Son of Man is invoked before the
Lord of Spirits, and his name in the presence
of the Ancient of Days.

It is written if any man will come after me -
let him deny himself and take up his cross
and follow me *

Adept - Hands Chain to aspirant, takes Wand and Blue Jewel
from him, lays them on the Pastos

Second Adept— Take therefore this Chain Oh Aspirant
and place it about thy neck and say:—
I accept the Bonds of Suffering and Self Sacrifice
This is done— Aspirant repeats the Words.
Rise then my Frater; in the symbol of self Renunciation
and extend thy arms in the form of a cross
All rise: aspirant will feet together and arms extended
Associate Adephies Minor take from the Alter
the Dagger of Penance, — and the
Cup of Tribulation —

that I may confirm the Vow of the Aspirant
for ever — by marking him afresh with
the stigmata of the cross.

Takes Dagger from Third adept, dips it in the
Cup and marks the Aspirant — as at the oblation
on the Forehead, both Insteps, both palms.
and finally pierces Dagger agst Heart: gives
Dagger back to 3rd adept who replaces them on
Alter & then gives the Aspirant the Rose an
Cross from off the Alter

Second Adept. Take that Symbol, raise it with
both hands above thy Head and say:—

"Thus will I uphold the Sign of Suffering
and of Strength"

And I heard the Voice of the King of Earth
cry aloud and say; -

He that aideth me in my suffering -

The same shall be partaker with me in my Ricing

Replace then Oh Aspirant that Cross upon
the Altar - and say

In and by that Sign I demand

That the Pastos ^{of} four Founder

Be opened; for my Victory is in
The Cross of the Rose.

For it is written "If ye ^{be} crucified with Christ
ye shall also reign with Him"

Third Adept - gives back to the Aspirant the Wand
and Cinx Ansata of the Chief Adept, - and
removes the Altar from off the Pastos, thus
showing the whole Pastos . he then opens
& throws down the upper Half Cover of the
Pastos - disclosing the Chief Adept within it

and 3rd Adept says -

And the Light shineth in the Darkness as
the Darkness comprehendeth it not.

Second Adept Touch with the head of thy Wand,
Rose and Cross upon the Breast of the
Form before Thee and say:-
"Out of the darkness let Light arise."

Aspirant repeats.

Chief Adept remaining still - speaks

Burned with that Light in a mystic
death

Rising again in a Mystical Resurrection
Cleansed and purified through Him our Master

Oh Brother of the Cross and Rose

Like Him, Oh Adepts of all ages, Have ye toiled
like Him have ye suffered Tribulation -

Poverty - torture - and death have ye pa-
through, they have been but the Purifiers
of the Gold. In the Alchemie of thine heart

X Through the Almanor of affliction

X Seek now the True Stone of the Wise.

Aspirant hands Wand and Crux Ansata
to Chief Adept, who gives in exchange
the Crook and the Scourge to Him.

Chief Adept continues

Dost thou this Vault then Oh Aspirant
with thine arms crossed upon thy Breast
bearing in thy right Hand the Crook of Mercy
and in thy left hand the Scourge of Severity
the emblems of those eternal forces belov'd
which in equilibrium the Universe dependeth.

Those forces whose Reconciliation is the Key of
Life, whose separation is evil and death
Therefore thou art inexcusable, whosoever thou art,
who judgest another - for in that thou judgest
another thou ^{condemnest} ~~judgest~~ thyself; Be thou therefore
Merciful even as the ~~the~~ Father who is in Heaven
is Merciful. Remember the tremendous obligation
of self sacrifice, and rectitude which thou hast
voluntarily taken upon thyself, and tremble
thereat; and let the humble prayer of thine
Heart be; - God be merciful unto me a sinner
and keep me in the Pathway of Truth.

Third Adept. Thus then did Frater N. N. and his companions, having moved aside the Circular Altar, and having raised the Bra plate or lid of the Pastos, discover the body of our Founder, with all the ornaments and insignia as here shewn before you. Upon his breast was the Book. It, a scrolle explaining in full the mystical Tarot at the end of which was written a brief paragraph concerning our Founder Christian Rosenkreuz, beneath which the earlier Frats had subscribed their names. Following this came the names of ~~the~~ ^{of the} Three Highest Chief of the Order viz

Frater Hugo Alverda, the Phrisian, in the 57⁶ year of his age

Frater Franciscus de Bry, the Gaul, in the 495⁴ year of his age.

Frater Elman Zata, the Arab, in the 463² year of his age.

Last of all was written
Ex Deo nascimur; In Iesu morimur
Per Spiritum Sanctum, reviviscimus.
