No difference in the Sash of 5"=6" for Theoricus, Practicus, and Philosophus Adeptus Minor. Because also, any difference added to the Sash would prevent its being worn in First Order Meetings. For each of these Sub-Grades there is a special Magical Implement (to be made by the Member for himself & on no account by another person) part, or the whole of which can be worn as a distinguishing jewel to mark his Grade.

<u>Theoricus Adeptus Minor</u>	= Ring and Disc for Divination. Ring can be worn as jewel.
<u>Practicus</u>	" = Crystal Orb & Tripod. Orb can be worn as jewel.
<u>Philosophus</u>	" = A certain hollow Cross for high plane walking.
<u>Adept</u>	" = Another somewhat similar in construction.

All the Sashes of the Second Order are white. — The Adept Adeptus Minor has a different Sash to the ordinary 5"=6" members. — These Sashes of the Second Order are to be worn crosswise over the ordinary 5"=6" sash, that is over the opposite shoulder.

The Sash of an Adept Adeptus Minor is white with golden border, and the Rose
