

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Selecting Initiates (Initiative Makes Initiates)

In selecting new members for the Order, the first consideration is "*How badly does this person need the Order?*" Do they want to work or are they merely looking for comfortable reassurance? Or sweet words about pie in the sky.

We cannot offer a cushion - only the Cross. Those who cannot stand the pace are a burden, not an asset. Strong, independent people re-enforce the Spirit of the Order.

Sure, we have the means to stimulate and to help in the 'dry' patches inevitable in The Quest, but not to carry people along the Path who have no drive of their own.

There are many times on the Path when we feel up against a blind end, but do we have the drive to get through?

Recall that in the 0=0 our path is blocked many times, although the Lamp of the Kerux leads us. "*Thou canst not pass by me, saith the Guardian of the West unless thou canst tell me my name*!" 'That's a curly one, we think How the hell would I know?

But then the ever-present Hegemon raises the hoodwink and we see a forbidding figure holding the Black Banner of the West and barring with a naked sword. As soon as our eyes have focused on this threatening figure the hoodwink falls back over our eyes. But in that brief moment the Power of the Black Pillar has struck right down through our entire being to the remotest point of Creation. Echoing through the vast corridors of Time, sounding through the caverns of the Darkness of the birth of Creation.

These links hardly touch the conscious mind, but they are there. Later, at the East we meet another mighty figure who yet poses the same challenge. 'Well, I got past the last one, perhaps I'll get by here.' we think. Sure enough help comes again from the faithful Hegemon.

A mighty figure in Red and White confronts us. Again our whole Being is momentarily illuminated by the Banner of Light and the Sceptre of Power and Animation. Again the figure states its purpose.
