The twelve principal Gods and Goddesses of Greece, and the Sefiroth of the Tree of Life

	Sefirah	Greek God	Roman	Comment	
1.	Kether	Poseidon	Neptune	Ruler of the Great Sea; Earth-shaker, Second son of Kronos and Rhea. Elder brother of Zeus.	
2.	Chokmah	Athene	Minerva	Goddess of Wisdom and Prudent War. She gave Fire to Prometheus. Daughter of Zeus and Metis; Virgin.	
3.	Binah	Hestia	Vesta	Goddess of Hearth Fires, Eldest child of Kronos and Rhea; thus the Elder sister of Demeter, Hera, Hades Poseidon and Zeus. Virgin.

4.	Gedulah	Zeus	Jupiter	Supreme Ruler of the Gods; Lord of the Sky, God of the Thunderbolt; Son of Kronos and Rhea. Zeus led his elder siblings in their war against Kronos.	
5.	Gevuralı	Ares	Mars	God of War and Bloodshed; Son of Zeus and Hera [or of Hera alone]. Hated by all the immortal gods, except his sister Eris [Hail Eris! All Hail Discordia! and Aphrodite, who became his lover.	
6.	Rachamim	Apollo	Apollo	God of the Sun and Light; God of Plagues; God of Oracles. Son of Zeus and Leto; twin of Artemis. He has no consort, but he has many children.	
7.	Netsach	Aphrodite	Venus	Goddess of Beauty and Love; Goddess of Fruitful Increase; Born from the Sea and the seed of Ouranos Mother of Eros, by Zeus or Hermes or Apollo.	
8.	Hodh	Hermes	Mercury	God of Magic; God of Travellers and Merchants; God of Liars and Thieves; Messenger of the Gods; Son of Zeus and Maia.	
9.	Yesodh	Artemis	Diana	Goddess of the Crescent New Moon; Goddess of the Hunt; Goddess of Plagues; Goddess of Childbirth; Twin sister of Apollo. Virgin.	
10.	Malkuth	Demeter	Ceres	Goddess of the Earth and the Cornfield; Goddess of the Marriage Union. Second daughter of Kronos. Mother of Koré [Persephone] by her brother Zeus. She has no husband, but many children.

11. Da"ath	Hephaistos	Vulcan	God of the Smithy and Metal craftsmanship. Son of Zeus and Hera. Consort of Aphrodite. He was crippled when Zeus broke his legs.
12. Sether	Hera	Јшю	A daughter of Kronos, she was tricked into marrying her brother Zeus. Originally, she was the Great Goddess of pre-Hellenic Greece, and she retained her stature as Queen of Heaven and Protector of the Marriage Vow. She often took revenge on the lovers of Zeus and their children.

An Alternative Set of Greek and Roman Gods on the Tree of Life

Here is another way of assigning Greek and Roman Gods to the Sefiroth of the Tree of Life, which includes other well known classical gods, while omitting some of the lesser known Olympian gods.
