The Forgotten Ones

An Invocation of No

Purpose:

To invoke No by establishing a nexus on the Cross through the body of the Initiate

Setting:

An altar is prepared in the North, with Pantacle, Air Dagger, Fire Wand and Cup (filled with water) and the bottle of Holy Oil. A Cross "couch" is prepared on the floor, head to the North.

A red and white intertwined spiral of dots is painted on the square of union. Over the Square of Union is the "Eye Globe", an arrangement of Mirrors forming an astral cube with the eye at its centre.

A white candle is placed above each Arm of the Cross. Sigils and Devices of No are engraved and filled on a red Tablet suspended above the foot of the Cross. All other décor is removed.

Background "music" is the sound of insects and frogs.

All remain South of the Arms of the Cross except when performing some other function. All remain silent at all times other than the chants. Priestess_1 and Priestess_2 shall serve as Altar Attendants.

Opening:

The Hierophant anoints each with Holy Oil, declares the Temple open and sounds the Bell once.

Priestess performs the Silent 8-Fold Banishing, while all hold the gesture of Harpocrates.

The text of The Forgotten Ones is played.

Consecration:

Priestess purifies, consecrates and enflames the Cross and the Tablet with water, air and fire.

Hierophant stands, disrobes and is purified, consecrated and enflamed by Priestess

Hierophant kneels before the Square of Union, facing the Altar.

Sanction:

All chant the invocation of Maat – IPSOS MAAT!

Sacrifice:

While all others continue to invoke Maat, Hierophant may sacrifice blood and/or sperm, which are applied to the red and white dots, respectively. Hierophant enrobes.

Invocation:

Hierophant stands over the Southernmost Square, facing the Altar, Priestess_1 stands facing him, and he performs the Consecrations and then steps aside so that she can lie on the Cross, her head over the Spiral. All chant IPSOS NO! Until Priestess_1 stands and enrobes

This is repeated by Priestess_2 (and Priestess_3). Hierophant lies on the Cross, without further Consecration.

Closing:

All assume Asana and chant IPSOS MAAT until Hierophant or Priestesses finish with IGNATOR!

Priestesses perform the Silent 8-Fold Banishing.

Hierophant sounds the Bell once and declares the Temple closed.
