The differing perceptions of the various individuals, societies and nations ensure this.

The matter of perception needs to be understood at a number of different levels.

It is our common assumption that if two visually unimpaired people look at the same thing from the same position, the image formed on their retinas will be the same.

It is further assumed that the light impinging upon each retina causes the same electrochemical reaction in all individuals; that the output of the eye will be the same in each case. On this basis we take it that the brain and the mind each receive the same data about the outside world.

Is this the same as both 'seeing' the same thing? No, it is not. One only has to compare the impressions two different individuals may have when first seeing, for example, a new car. One, a mechanic, will notice technical details, performance characteristics, etc. The other, a prospective purchaser, will notice colour, shape, comfort and status features.

This 'selective seeing' occurs all the time, largely subconsciously. While there is no doubt that the same data is available, each observer will apply a unique set of rules or judgments determining what aspects of the image are deemed important. This set of rules is derived from a mix of intelligence, education and conditioning.

It is entirely possible to gain conscious control of the seeing process – learning to see without judgment, to take in the entire dataset, and then, if necessary, analyzing the image in accordance with the specific, immediate need.

It would be easy to argue that this 'selective seeing' constitutes some form of internal censorship. I would argue that this is not the case. The full data is stored, however as no significance has been given to some aspects of the image, it is very difficult to access – the memory keys have not been established.
