Points on Foot (Dorsal Aspect): Di Wu Hui


- <u>LOCATION</u>: Di Wu Hui is located in the depression proximal to the heads of the 4th and 5th metatarsal bones.

Points on Foot (Dorsal Aspect): Liu Wan


- LOCATION: Liu Wan is located between the 4th and 5th metatarsal bones, 0.5 cun distal to the metatarsal and phalangeal joint.


Points on Foot (Dorsal Aspect): *Mu Dou*

- <u>LOCATION</u>: Mu Dou is located between the 3rd and 4th metatarsal bones, 0.5 cun distal to the metatarsal and phalangeal joint.

Points on Foot (Dorsal Aspect): *Men Jin*

- LOCATION: Men Jin is located in the depression directly distal to the junction of the 2nd and 3rd metatarsal bones, parallel to Huo Zhu.

Points on Foot (Dorsal Aspect): Xian Gu (ST 43)

- <u>LOCATION</u>: Xian Gu is located in the depression distal to the junction of the 2nd and 3rd metatarsal bones.

Points on Foot (Dorsal Aspect): Nei Ting (ST 44)

- <u>LOCATION</u>: Nei Ting is located proximal to the web margin between the 2nd and 3rd toes, in the depression distal and lateral to the 2nd metatarsodigital joint.

Points on Foot (Dorsal Aspect): Mu Fu

- <u>LOCATION</u>: Mu Fu is located 0.3 cun lateral to the center of the middle segment of the 2nd toe.

- <u>LOCATION</u>: Huo Zhu is located in the depression directly distal to the junction of the 1st and 2nd metatarsal bones, 1.0 cun proximal to Huo Ying.

Points on Foot (Dorsal Aspect): Tai Chong (LR 3)

- <u>LOCATION</u>: Tai Chong is located in the depression distal to the junction of the 1st and 2nd metatarsal bones.




Points on Foot (Dorsal Aspect): Xing Jian (LR 2)


- <u>LOCATION</u>: Xing Jian is located between 1st and 2nd toes, proximal to the margin of the web.




Points on Foot (Dorsal Aspect): Da Dun (LR 1)

- <u>LOCATION</u>: Da Dun is located on the lateral side of the terminal phalanx of the great toe, between the lateral corner of the nail and the interphalangeal joint.








Points on Foot (Plantar Aspect): Fu Ling 1

- <u>LOCATION</u>: Fu Ling 1 is located at the lateral end of the proximal interphalangeal crease of the 2nd toe.

- <u>LOCATION</u>: Fu Ling 2 is located at the medial end of the proximal interphalangeal crease of the 2nd toe.

Points on Foot (Plantar Aspect): *Hua Gu 1* (a four-point unit)

<u>LOCATION</u>: Hua Gu 1 are located between the 1st and 2nd metatarsal bones.


Hua Gu 1

- □ 1st point: 0.5 cun proximal to the joint of the big toe and 2nd toe
- 2nd point: 0.5 cun proximal to 1st point
- □3rd point: 0.5 cun proximal to 2nd point
- □ 4th point: 0.8 cun proximal to 3rd point



Points on Foot (Plantar Aspect): *Hua Gu 2* (a two-point unit)


- <u>LOCATION</u>: Hua Gu 2 are located between the 2nd and 3rd metatarsal bones.
 - 1st point: 1.0 cun proximal to the joint of the two toes
 - □ 2nd point: 0.5 cun proximal to 1st point

Points on Foot (Plantar Aspect): Hua Gu 3








Points on Foot (Plantar Aspect): Yong Quan (KI 1)

- LOCATION: San Sheng 1, 2, 3 are uniformly located on the median plane (midsagittal plane) of the plantar surface of the foot.

 - San Sheng 2: 2 cun proximal to K-1
 - ☐ San Sheng 3: 3 cun proximal to K-1


- LOCATION: Tian Huang is located 3.0 cun superior to Ming Huang, on the Foot Jue Yin Liver channel.








Points on Lower Limb (Lateral Aspect): Shang Jiu Li




- For grave's dz; *hyperthyroidism*:
 - Use Liu Wei Di Huang Wan 75% + Bu Zhong Yi Qi Tang 25% or Thyrodex
- *Hypothyroidism*: hai zao + kun bu
 - These are the kelp / sargasum herbs with lots of iodine. They also soften nodules
 - For goiter; also Thyro-forte
 - □ Hai dai also a kelp type of herb




Points on Lower Limb (Lateral Aspect): Yi Chong (Yi Zhong)









Points on Lower Limb (Anterior Aspect): Tong Shan

LOCATION: Tong Shan is located on the anterior midline of the femur, 2.0 cun superior to Tong Guan.




- Rx: Dang Gui Shao Yao San
- With spleen qi def: add Bu Zhong Yi Qi Tang.
- With excessive bleeding: add Gui Pi Tang + Xian He Cao + Qian Cao Gen
- With kidney def (chi weak): add Liu Wei Di Huang Wan
- For Liver type: add Xiao Yao San

Allergy – affecting the nose

- Cang Er San (xanthium fruit powder) wind heat (yellow thick nasal discharge)
- Xin Yi San (magnolia flower powder) wind cold (clear watery discharge)
- Or Tan's combines both formulas at 50:50% ratio and give them to the patient together.



Allergy – affecting the nose

- If it is a sinus infection: use Qing Bi Tang to clear damp-heat
- If dry: add <u>Mai Men Dong Tang</u> or <u>Bai He Gu</u> <u>Jin Tang</u>
- If wet: add Xiao Qing Long Tang (Minor Blue Dragon Decoction)
- If fever: add Zi Yin Jiang Huo Tang (nourish yin to descend fire decoction)
