

The Oracle of the Triad consists of 57 cards representing concepts which have always led and challenged mankind. This deck helps to grasp the materialistic problems related to our worldly dimension. It is also a mirror reflecting our soul and therefore guiding anyone in search of spirituality and self-understanding.

Each of us holds deep inside ourselves the answers to all our questions whatever the level of complexity. But we often forget to look at ourselves. The Oracle of the Triad helps to unveil the cosmic dimension we belong to, body and soul, and that glows in each human being.

Each card has been elaborated according to very precise symbolic concepts from ancient and more recent religions and philosophies. The illustration created is a synthesis of several symbols in relation to the basic value of the card making the Oracle of the Triad is a special deck as much for its content as for its form.

These powerfully symbolic cards are for everyone, amateur or professional. They are helpful tools towards a deeper understanding of oneself and provide a doorway for inner growth.



READING THE CARDS

There is no specific method for reading this deck of cards. It is thanks to the reader's sensitivity and perception of the deck that an accurate reading can be made. To help you to get started with the Oracle of the Triad, here are three different reading methods.

THE READING IN TRIANGLE

Shuffle and cut the deck. Make a fan with the cards face down. Then pull 3 cards and place them as shown below. Choose a fourth card and place it in the center of the others.



Card n°1 represents the forces in action on the object of the question.


Card n°2 indicates the forthcoming outcome or the behaviour to adopt in order to solve the problem.

Card n°3 represents the possible outcome of the problem.

Card n°4 gives a final answer, a clearer vision of the issue. It provides a synthesis.

THE READING OF THE TRIAD

Shuffle and cut the deck. The two cards under each pack indicate the forces in presence on the question. Then, put all the cards together again, make a fan, face down and choose 12 cards. Dispose them as shown below:



The cards are interpretated by groups of three.

Cards 1, 2 and 3 represent what directly concerns the questioner, his/her attitude and/or relation to the matter.

Cards 4, 5 and 6 represent the exterior events to the questioner and his/her surrounding.


Cards 7, 8 and 9 represent a suggestion of how to

behave in the near future, or the near future itself. Cards 10, 11 and 12 represent the outcome.

You can choose a thirteenth card if you need more precision on the attitude to adopt to deal positively with the matter.

TRADITIONAL CROSS READING

Suffle and cut the deck. Then choose 5 cards and place them as shown below:



Card n°1 represents what is favorable to the question.

Card n°2 represents what is acting against the question. Card n°3 represents what dominates, the major strength, be it positive or not.

Card n° 4 represents the possible outcome.

Card n°5 is the synthesis. It may be covered once or twice for a clearer understanding.

INTERPRETING THE CARDS

The following list is not exhaustive. It gives a guideline. Depending on the question and/or on the cards' combinations, interpretation can vary extensively. Therefore, it's up to the individual, depending on the reading, to relate these notions to the question, finding deep within themselves the link between both question and cards.
