# Introduction

The art of fortune telling with playing cards has been around for centuries and there are various methods to choose from. Some people use all the cards of the deck and some use part of it while others buy special fortune telling cards known as Tarot Cards. The method illustrated in this book originates from the Middle East using regular playing cards. This method was taught to me by my great aunt of Persian / Turkish heritage.

In Middle Eastern fortune telling you use one deck of cards discarding all the twos, threes, fours, and fives, so you are left with a deck of 36 cards. In the readings when we refer to the deck of cards, we mean a deck consisting of the 36 cards.

Each card can have multiple meanings plus its location can also make a difference. Is it in the future or part of the past? Is it between or before auspicious cards, or inauspicious ones? What types of cards dominate the reading? After some practice, you should be able to get the hang of it and it will become like second nature. In fact, once you master our spreads, nothing should prevent you from coming up with your own spreads.

This book is divided into four main sections. You have a cheat sheet to help you glance at the meaning of the cards and to give some helpful hints. Then you will be taught how to lay out cards and learn some spreads. Afterwards, one page is dedicated to the meaning of each card of the deck.

Finally, there is a sample spread with interpretation as a guide to help you learn the art of fortune telling.

This book is meant to be used for entertainment purposes. Even though it is fun trying to find out what lies ahead in our lives, whether it is actually possible or not is the million dollar question. Some people have special powers and some use the cards as an aide. I am not making any claims or giving any special power to the subject. You can consult the cards and use your intuitive power trying to predict upcoming events. Telling fortune can also be like solving a puzzle. At the end of the day, you are the master of your own destiny and responsible for your own decisions.

I hope you enjoy this e-book and have fun with your friends and family.

# **Cheat sheet and other hints**

Aces: Signing of documents. Promises. Partnerships.

Kings: A male person in a high position. Professionals. An older person.

Queens: Females. Birth. New beginnings.

Jacks: Younger people. Protector.

Tens: Achievements. Success.

Nines: Movement. Building. In the process of making.

Eights: News. Events.

Sevens: Legal documents. Paperwork. Legalization. End of waiting.

Sixes: Path. Trips. Vacations. Going away.

#### **Red Numbered Cards**

Finding red numbered cards after any other cards gives them a more positive outlook. For example if a red numbered card falls by a sickness card, then it means recovery from that sickness.

#### Clubs

Clubs are usually about your shared life either with a partner or a spouse. It can represent your love life or business life.

#### Spades

Spades are generally inauspicious cards; however, if red numbered cards fall after them (on their right side) then you can change their meaning to a more positive one.

If you find a **King of Spades**, **9 of Spades**, **8 of Spades** and **6 of Spades** (all four together but not necessarily in that order) on top of the consultant card then it means death. However it would not be proper practice to advise anyone regarding this matter as these readings are only for entertainment purposes. Meanwhile if you get 3 of the mentioned cards with a red numbered card, then it means recovery from a sickness or recovery from an accident.

If you find **4 Aces** in the entire reading, it is an indication of a very good fortune.

#### Choosing a face card as the Consultant

Widowed or Divorced Female = Queen of Spades Married Female = Queen of Clubs Engaged Female = Queen of Diamonds Single Female = Queen of Hearts

Divorced or Widowed Male = Jack of Spades Married Male = Jack of Clubs Engaged Male = Jack of Diamonds Single Male = Jack of Hearts

# **Spreads**

### **The Main Spread**

The first thing to do is to choose the consultant card. For married females use the *Queen of Clubs*. For widowed or divorced females choose *Queen of Spades*. For single females use *Queen of Hearts* and for engaged ladies choose *Queen of Diamonds*.

For married men use *Jack of Clubs*. For single and men use *Jack of Hearts*. For engaged men use *Jack of Diamonds* and for divorced or widowed gentlemen use *Jack of Spades*.

#### Step 1


You start by putting the face card representing the consultant in the middle of the spread.

The consultant then takes the deck and shuffles them to their satisfaction and then cuts the deck with his/her left hand into two piles.

You will take the bottom part of the cut deck and place it on top of the rest of the deck.

From the top of the deck you will draw 20 cards and place them face up as indicated below.

Card numbers 15, 17, 19 and 21 are placed on top of the consultant card face down.



Cards **2** and **3** indicate present situation or event. Issues that are faced by the consultant at this point in time.

Cards **4** and **5** indicate the thoughts and desires of the consultant.

Cards **6** and **7** indicate possibility of what might happen in the near future.

Cards **8** and **9** represent the past or issues that are not of importance anymore.

You need to connect and read together the following cards: **10** and **14** with **11** and **16**.

Then you will connect card numbers **12** and **18** with **13** and **20**.

The last four cards left on the consultant card (numbers **15**, **17**, **19** and **21**) are the conclusion of the spread. These cards relate to the consultant's most inner wishes. They can also represent the most important situation in the consultant's life at this moment.


#### Step 2

After you finish reading all the cards from step 1, then you will remove two cards at a time in this order:

 Remove cards of that have the same number or face value and are of the same color first. For example 7 of hearts with 7 of diamonds or Jack of Clubs with Jack of Spades are removed first. However, you will never remove the consultant card. Once all same number or face cards and same color cards are removed then,

 Remove the same numbered or face cards regardless of color obviously.

Whatever cards are left you take them and count them. If you have less than 13 cards (including the consultant card) you put them aside and take the discarded cards and any leftover form the pile, shuffle them and ask the consultant to draw randomly enough cards to make up 13 cards. Shuffle the 13 cards and lay them as follows:



Then you need to read the cards horizontally and vertically. So first read the **first row**, **second row**, **third row** and the **fourth row**. Then read card numbers **1**, **4**, **7**, and **10** followed by **2**, **5**, **8** and **11**, followed by **3**, **6**, **9** and **12**. Finally read the last card number **13**.

Once you are finished reading the cards, except the consultant card, remove all other cards two by two, following the same rules outlined on page 8/9. The leftover cards are the final conclusion of this spread. You take the leftover cards, shuffle them and lay them down in rows of 5. If you have 5 cards or less you will only have one row, otherwise you may end up with 2 rows. Read these cards.


#### Step 3

If the consultant has other questions that he or she would like an answer to, then shuffle all the cards and give them to the consultant. Ask the consultant to draw 2 cards from anywhere from the deck. Put these 2 cards next to each other. Read the cards. If the meaning of them is vague, you can draw one more card to get clarity.

If you get 2 Spades it means that the consultant will not get that wish. If the consultant has more than one wish or question, you can keep shuffling and repeating this process. Most readers answer 3 wishes or questions for the consultant.


#### **Main Spread Variation**

This spread is basically the smaller version of the main reading, choosing only 17 cards. You do not need to remove any cards. However, you can offer to answer the consultant's question at the end.



#### Four by four Spread

Take out the consultant card. Shuffle the cards well and ask the consultant to draw 16 cards. Shuffle these 17 cards (16 plus the consultant card) and spread them four rows by four columns, as shown below.



# First read **row 1 to 4**, then read each **column (1, 5, 9, 13 as one**). After reading card number **17** as indicated in the major spread remove two cards at a time as explained previously. The leftover cards are the conclusion of the reading.

You can still offer to answer the questions as a bonus for the consultant.

# The Meaning of the cards

In this section you will find the meaning of the cards used in this fortune telling technique. Some cards have more than one meaning and you need to tap into your intuition and surrounding cards to match the best meaning for your consultant.

Also the term Deck used in this book constitutes of the following cards.



## Ace of clubs

Signing of legal contracts which will connect people or businesses together. Ace of clubs acts as a connector. You need at least two entities or two people to benefit from this type of agreement or connection.

Fortune. Business luck and success. Good financial news. Monetary gain. Business opportunities. Beginning of a successful business or financial venture. Winning. Victory.

After numbered hearts is an indication of financial success and monetary gain.

After Numbered Clubs would emphasize business and partnership luck and success.

With 10 of Clubs shows a great period of luck and prosperity.

After 7, 9, or 10 of Spades would indicate that positive outcome is possible with a little hard work.



### Ace of Diamonds

An anticipated agreement or contract will be realized which will also bring financial satisfaction.


Great card for financial matters. Inheritance. New and beneficial business venture. Winnings (like lottery).

Next to numbered hearts would indicate luck.

Next to numbered Clubs confirms that any type of partnership will be successful.

After 7, 9 or 10 of Spades is an indication of desired outcome after hardship.

With 10 of Diamonds shows a major victory or agreement especially in finances. A windfall.



### Ace of Hearts

Ace of Hearts is related to the matter of hearts, emotions and new beginnings.

Marriage. Joy. Happiness. Good News. Beginning of Romance. Love. Hope. New beginnings.

For single people it can indicate an engagement.


An emotional agreement which will make you very happy.

Next to numbered hearts confirms luck, happiness and love.

Next to Clubs would indicate that success is on the way.

After any negative card (mostly spades) offers hope and positive outcome.

With 10 of Hearts tells you that you will get your wish.



### Ace of Spades


Having to sign a document that will not necessarily be beneficial or pleasant. Being forced into an agreement.

Disagreement. Divorce. Separation. Be cautious of what you sign.

If positive cards; mostly hearts, fall after the Ace of Spades then the outcome can become positive.

If Ace of Spades falls between positive cards it shows some hardship to get the desired outcome.

With 7, 9 or 10 of spades can indicate a period of bad luck, poor outcome, hardship, divorce, separation, unemployment or sickness.



### **Six of Clubs**

Going on a trip or vacation with a partner or friend. An important decision will be made with another person. Traveling for education.


Reaching a mutual and satisfactory decision.

A path that leads to partnerships. Reunions.

Between Spades would indicate to beware of any upcoming opportunities for a partnership, delays in travelling plans, or lack of opportunities.

With Diamonds would mean a path that leads to financial success.

With numbered Clubs would emphasis on the success whether work or education related.



### Six of Diamonds


Travel for work. Finding employment in a different location. Relocation. Money coming form abroad.

Finding a way to change your financial situation for better. Being on the path to financial success.

Investments in stock market would be advantageous.

After any numbered Spades would mean change or relocation after some delay.

Between numbered Spades would indicate cancellation of relocations plans, or not receiving the job offer you were expecting.




### **Six of Hearts**

Finding love at a different location. Long distance relationship. Traveling to meet a lover.

A dream vacation.

A path which leads to love and romance.

Before 7, 9 or 10 of Spades would indicate that the long distance romance or relationship would not last.



### Six of Clubs

An unexpected trip or finding an unexpected solution.


Whether this trip is good or bad it is related to the neighbouring cards.

Between numbered Spades would indicated of a trip what will be taken out of obligations. A sad trip such as going to visit a sick person.

Between numbered Hearts would mean finding unexpected love or friendship abroad or at a distance. A pleasant situation.

Between numbered Diamond cards would indicate an unexpected situation which may lead to monetary gain and achievements.

Between numbered Club cards would mean a partnership would arise out of an unexpected situation or trip.



### **Seven of Clubs**

Buying a property with your partner. Signing legal documents.

New vehicle. Going on a trip with your partner. Taking trips most likely with cars.

Before 7, 9 or 10 of Spades would indicate cancelled plans or cancelled trips. Also read the fine lines before signing any documents.

Between numbered Clubs would indicate an agreement that is financially beneficial to both parties involved.




### **Seven of Diamonds**

Monetary news. Move to better place or location. Change of residence. Promotion.

Travel by airplane.

Before 7, 9 or 10 of Spades would warn of an accident, cancellations of trip and plans.

Between numbered Clubs would mean a change that will enhance your family life and relationships.




#### **Seven of Hearts**

Possibility of an engagement or a wedding. Love. Great Friendship.

Marriage proposal. Getting engaged.

Between numbered Spades would indicate breaking up an engagement. Dispute.

Between numbered hearts would indicate a great and lasting love.



#### **Seven of Spades**


Legal problem. Business failure. Divorce.

Unfortunate events. Having to give up.

Between numbered Diamond cards would indicate finding a way to prevent financial loss.

Between numbered Heart cards means getting back together or victory after heartache.

Between numbered Clubs would mean that the consultant needs to work harder to prevent loss and failure.



# **Eight of Clubs**

Good and favourable news which you and your partner have been waiting for. Beginning of new adventure in your personal life.

Exciting times. Good change. Move with regards to some type of partnership.

Next to numbered clubs shows great success coming your way.

Next to the King of Spades is an indication of Divine intervention for great success.

Before 7, 9 or 10 of Spades would indicate bad news or partnerships not working out.




## **Eight of Diamonds**

Good financial news. Disappearance of financial or work related worries.

Promotion. Education. Gaining new knowledge or skill which will help your career.

If 8 of diamonds falls before 7, 9 or 10 of Spades, then it would mean failure, demotion, or disappointing news.



## **Eight of Hearts**

News of a marriage. Good and auspicious news.


A love letter or message. Making new friends.

Before other numbered hearts is an indication of success in your love life.

Between numbered clubs is an indication of successful relations. Success at work, school or other undertakings.

Between numbered Diamonds indicates a marriage or a relationship which will also be financially stable.

Before 7, 9 or 10 of Spades shows arguments, disappointments, sad news, or news of a break-up.



### **Eight of Spades**

Unexpected news. A surprise. Unexpected events.

Whether this news or event is good or bad is related to the neighbouring cards.

Between or before numbered Heart would indicate an unexpected love or friendship.

Before numbered Diamonds shows unexpected financial news. Having an unexpected opportunity to make money.


Before numbered Clubs shows of a possibility of an unexpected partnership.

Before 7, 9 or 10 of Spades represents a bad surprise, events falling out of control or sickness.

Next to any face card except King of Spades would indicate receiving unexpected news or a surprise from that person.

Next to the Ace of Spades shows that events are out of control.

You need to look at other cards surrounding the 8 of spades to determine whether the situation at hand would turn positive or negative.



### **Nine of Clubs**

News of a marriage. Life partner. Building a life together. Moving in together.

Possibility of conception. Pregnancy.

Achievements at work or school.

Next to other Clubs indicates achieving your goal with the help of another person or your partner.

Next to Diamonds can represent moving in a direction or being in a path that leads to financial gain.

Before 7, 9 or 10 of Spades would indicate a misfortune or miscarriage.



### **Nine of Diamonds**


News, letter, or a phone call regarding some financial matters.

Partnership. On the road to prosperity. Financial gain. Good for real estate matters.

An employment proposal. Chance to make money.

Before 7, 9 or 10 of Spades would indicate arguments especially about finances.

Between numbered Spades can be loss of investment. Better hold off investing in stocks or properties.




### Nine of Hearts

Finding success in an emotional situation. Happiness. Pure joy.

Happy home environment. Taking advantages of upcoming events.

Before 7, 9 or 10 of Spades may indicate hopelessness, anger, or simply not getting your wish.

Next to other numbered Hearts it is a dream come through.



### **Nine of Spades**

Disappointing financial matters. Loss. Theft. Bankruptcy.


Depression. Guilt. Sorrow. Sad news.

Next to another numbered Spade would just emphasis the adversity of the situation.

Next to the King of Spades indicates an adversity in disguise. Out of a bad situation, something good will happen.

Between red numbered cards would lessen the effect of the bad luck or situation.

Between Ace of Hearts, Ace of Diamonds or Ace of Clubs shows triumph and victory in the face of difficulties.



# **Ten of Clubs**

Great financial or business success which involves another person or partner. Inheritance.

A fruitful partnership. Starting a profitable business with a partner.

Next to 10 of Diamonds would indicate great success.

Next to 10 or Ace of Hearts would indicate ultimate happiness and pleasure.



### **Ten of Diamonds**

Money. Wealth. Abundance.


Success in a financial matter.

Purchase of large items such as a house, a car or stocks.

Between numbered Spades would indicate a problem in getting what you deserve. Loss in the stock market. Alternatively postpone any plans of purchasing large items.

Between numbered Clubs would mean wealth and abundance coming with the help of others.

Next to Ten of Hearts, Ten of Clubs, Ace of Hearts, Ace of Diamonds and Ace of Clubs means ultimate good luck.



### **Ten of Hearts**


Great love. Finding your love or soul mate. A meaningful relationship

Harmony and bliss in relationships.

Joy and pure happiness.

Before 7, 9 or 10 of Spades would indicate heartache, hardship or loss of a great friendship or love.

Next to the Ace of Hearts and Ace of Clubs would indicate ultimate happiness and bliss in romantic relations.



### **Ten of Spades**

Financial worries. Loans., Mortgages. Being in debt.


Loss of employment. Unprofitable business, Being deceived.

Failure. Theft.

Between numbered Spades would indicate a disastrous situation.

Between Ace and Ten of Diamonds indicates having means to pay off loans and debts.

Before 9 or 10 of Clubs shows it is possible to change a non-profitable situation around.



### **Jack of Clubs**

Chosen as the consultant card if the male consultant is married.

Young married man (usually under 40). A family man. A man who loves his family and does everything to keep them happy.

Helping others. A loyal and trusting friend.

An important visitor.

Before 7, 9 or 10 of Spades would indicate problems and difficulties for a young married man.



## Jack of Diamonds

Chosen as the consultant card, if the male consultant is engaged.


A young man, most likely engaged or in a serious relationship.

In the process of building or guarding a financial relationship.

An investment that will appreciate over time.

Money coming from various sources. Promotion. Raise.

Property or real estate matters will be successful.




### **Jack of Hearts**

Chosen as the consultant card if the male consultant is single.

Agreeable young man. A lover. A lucky person.

Finding and experiencing love. Beginning of romance. Keeping love alive. Kindness.

Between two numbered Spades would indicate delay in finding love. A temporary separation or things are not as they seem.



### **Jack of Spades**

Young man (usually under 40) who is depressed. A person who is emotionally or physical unwell.

Feeling depressed. Anxious. Worried. Lack of trust. Lack of sleep.

A situation is making you nervous.

Next to other numbered Spades would indicate a need to get help or an intervention.

Next to red numbered cards, it offers hope, feeling better, or getting your life back on track.



## **Queen of Clubs**

Chosen as the consultant card if the consultant is female and married.

The card of partnership. A partner. Finding your path in life.

Receiving help from a married woman.

For younger consultants can be their mother or a mother figure.




# **Queen of Diamonds**

Chosen as the consultant card if the female consultant is engaged.

Getting engaged. Younger female.

Monetary gain. Getting rich. Getting a position or having employment which will be financially beneficial.



## **Queen of Hearts**

Chosen as the consultant card if the consultant is a single female.

Falling in love. Finding out if someone is in love with you.

Love. Friendship. Happiness.

A very nice and helpful friend.



### **Queen of Spades**

Chosen as the consultant card if the female consultant is widowed or divorced.

Experienced woman. Woman of age. Widowed. Being alone. Loneliness.

Not a good time for romantic relations.

Independence.



# King of Clubs

A powerful, generous and well positioned man. Man of the house.

If the consultant is Queen of Clubs, King of Clubs is normally her husband.

For Queen of Hearts, Queen of Diamonds and Queen of Spades can indicate a love interest.



## **King of Diamonds**

A person in a high position. Managers. Directors. Professionals.

An older person usually over 40 with financial backings.

Reaching your financial goals. Moving up the ladder. Promotion. Bonuses.

For older woman can be a love interest.



### **King of Hearts**

Receiving good news from a loving man or male friend (usually over 40). Happiness brought through a loving gentle man.

Your father or a father figure may play a positive and important part in your life.

Depending on the surrounding cards, this person, a father figure, or a friend, can be of assistance.

For older woman can be a love interest.



**King of Spades** 

Ultimate power. Universal power. Willpower.

Indicator of ultimate protection for the consultant.

In the hands of God or universe. Fate. Destiny.

If it shows up to answer the consultant's question, it indicates that whatever is in his or her advantage and best interest will happen.


This is a very powerful card which can change the course of the reading from a negative to a positive one.

# A sample spread

This sample reading is for a single young woman.

- 1- Take out the Queen of Hearts and place it on the consultant spot.
- 2- Hand the deck to the consultant and ask her to shuffle and cut the deck in to two piles.
- 3- Start spreading face up as explained previously on page 5.

If you know the consultant, then reading the spreads would be easier. For example, if the consultant is a friend and a student then you can use the relevant meanings. If she is looking for love, you can use the relevant meanings of each card. However, if you read for strangers then you need to incorporate different meaning of each card into play. You need to look at the whole reading first and see what cards are predominant. If there are lots of diamonds, then money is an issue, if you see lots of hearts, then we are mainly dealing with emotional issues. You will also learn to get a feeling of the whole reading the more you practice.



Eight of Diamonds with Eight of Spades: If you have not already, you will very soon receive good news regarding employment (or if she is student about education). This news will have some financial significance for you.

Seven of Hearts and Queen of Clubs: A married woman will either be of great help to you or a woman will help you in legalizing a matter you have been waiting for.

Six of Clubs with Queen of Spades: You may be going on a trip with a widowed or divorced woman. Alternatively you will reach an important and satisfactory decision with this woman.

Jack and King of Diamonds: It also shows that you are putting behind an important relationship you have had with a professional man or alternatively if the consultant is very career oriented can be that professionally she had been promoted to a better position.

Jack of Hearts with Queen of Diamonds: There may be an opportunity for a nice young man who is related to the consultant (both hearts) to become financially stable.

Eight of Clubs and Jack of Spades: This opportunity has been provided by a widowed or a divorced man which may also be beneficial to the consultant.

(Remember you should connect the meaning of cards 10, 14, 11, and 16)

8 of Hearts and 10 of Clubs: The consultant will soon be involved in a very successful and meaningful relationship which can lead to marriage.

Ace of Diamonds and 9 of Hearts: You will also have some money luck and a happy home environment.

Now pick up and open the four cards on top of the consultant:

Ace of Hearts, King of Hearts, 9 of Clubs, and Jack of Clubs


Now remove cards 2 by 2 as explained earlier.

So the following cards were removed:

Jack of Spades with Jack of Clubs Eight of Spades with Eight of Clubs Queen of Spades with Queen of Clubs Eight of Hearts with Eight of Diamonds Ace of Hearts with Ace of Diamonds King of Hearts with King of Diamonds Jack of Hearts with Jack of Diamonds We cannot find any more perfect match so we remove: Nine of Hearts with Nine of Clubs

At this time we have 5 cards left. The consultant needs to shuffle all the leftover cards and draw 8 more cards so we have 13 cards all together.

After laying down the cards face up we have the following:



First we read each row as follows:

Six of Hearts, Six of Clubs and Ace of Diamonds: You will be going on a romantic vacation with your partner which will be very enjoyable.

Ace of Spades, Queen of Hearts (the consultant) and Queen of Diamonds: There may be a few road blocks at reaching your financial goals. Also read the fine lines before signing any major document.

Eight of Spades, 10 of Club and 9 of Hearts: There will be an unexpected opportunity for you and someone else for a very profitable joint venture or partnership which will make you very happy as well.

King of Hearts, King of Diamonds, Ace of Clubs: There is also a possibility of your partner and your father or a father figure to do some business with each other that will be very lucky and prosperous.

Now we read each column:



7 of Hearts: Again marriage card is closing your fortune.


Once again we have to remove the cards 2 by 2, after shuffling, we lay the cards down in rows of 5 (in this case only one row):



This engagement is totally unexpected and you will be happily surprised. There is also success in what you plan to do. This was a great reading.

If you notice this consultant did not have many Spades in her reading. If you look generally, you will notice lots of red cards. Her concentration was mostly on her career and love life. Now we can ask her to make a wish and see if it comes through or ask a specific question. It is better for the consultant not to repeat what the fortune has already confirmed i.e. her love life and promotion.

The consultant was planning to take a short trip in December and was wondering if the timing was ok or should it be postponed? She drew the following cards:



The 6 of Clubs shows the trip she has been planning. The Ace of Spades shows that the timing may have been off. But because 6 of Spades comes AFTER the Ace of Spades then the answer would be YES, it is fine to take the trip according to this reading. However, if 6 of Clubs came first and Ace of Spades came after, then the answer would have been No. It is better to postpone the trip.
