THE POWER OF CHANTS, SPELLS AND RITUALS

Chants, spells and rituals are as old as man himself. Always turned to when man is in need chants, spells and rituals harness the magickal power within man's subconscious and puts him in contact with forces greater than himself. Chants and rituals are the working tools of what we call "magick"; simple gestures, uttered words, seemingly illogical actions, frowned upon by the "scientific" mind nevertheless make strange and wonderful things happen for the person who believes and performs them. They are instruments of *power*, and sometimes very awesome power.

Belief

Whilst chants, spells and rituals are the instruments of magickal practice it can also be said that *belief* is the driving force behind them. Without the element of belief

in the magician's working everything else is rendered useless. One must believe that what one is doing is purposeful and will achieve the objective that one is doing it for. Second thoughts, doubts, misgivings are lethal; they will make all your work a waste of time. A spell or ritual performed in a spirit of *belief, desire* and *faith* has a head start in achieving what is required of it by the magician. Always bear this in mind. For the reader who seeks more information on the value of belief I would refer them to "*How to Tap the Magic Power in Spells, Incantations, Prayers and Psalms*" by Geoffrey Samson, published by Finbarr Books, which contains much of interest to the reader of this present work.

What Chants are

The world of chants, spells and rituals is such a big one, with thousands of such formulae available to the enquiring reader, and a thousand different ways of doing them, that we shall try to keep to basics; showing the reader the way of letting him or her decide for his/herself what to do. First let us discuss what exactly is the nature and structure of chants, spells and rituals. Let us take first *chants*. A chant is simply a *sung version of a spell*. It usually rhymes; rhyming quality enhancing the power and appeal of the chant. A chant, chanted over and over again builds real psychic power. Repetition is a strong factor in building psychic energy, so important to all works of magick.

Definition of a Spell

A spell, simply defined, is a *set of words spoken which are believed to exert a magickal effect on a situation*

which the person uttering the spell seeks to change. The meaning of a spell is based upon the very primitive belief that to speak a desire is to *cause the desire to be fulfilled.* Such a simplistic view has been endorsed by Master Occultists through the passing of time as being in conformity with occult and cosmic laws. The trick in making the spell to possess meaning and fuelling it with the power to achieve its purpose, is to (1) speak the spell with belief and force and (2) the words employed in the spell mention *fulfilment* of that which is desired. It is not enough to speak of one's desire, one must also speak of its *materialisation* for otherwise there is no point to the whole exercise. Whilst spells are usually spoken they are not always so; a spell can also be cast by *thinking clearly and positively* about its words; *thinking* the words rather than speaking them. To firmly *desire* and *believe* that you will have what you desire, without the formality of magickal ceremony and gestures, is itself a spell. Tens of thousands of people have achieved their heart's desires by believing that they *will* receive them without any recourse to spells and rituals. But as Witches and Occultists have discovered through the centuries the use of spells and rituals is a much easier way of invoking inner powers for the attainment of objectives. To *speak* one's desire is one better than just *thinking* it.

Meaning of Ritual

In the practice of magick, ritual can be defined as a *set of gestures and actions designed to precipitate the coming to pass of what the magician seeks.* Much of ritual is mimicry in nature. Our cave man ancestors used to act out the motions of a successful hunt before they set out to acquire their food requirements; by ritualistically

mimicking the outcome they desired their faith was increased and invariably a successful hunt followed. One can recognise the power of *suggestion* at work here, ie. believing that a certain action will bring you success, the "believing" principle being the real cause of success rather than the intervention of supernatural forces. Much of magick is indeed dependent on the power of suggestibility, but that does not demean the usefulness of working the rituals involved. The "real" magick is performed within the mind; whilst external supernatural agencies play their part they are indeed secondary to the marvellous power of man's subconscious mind. The Master Occultists of today's world believe this implicitly. However, those who imply that a recognition of the mind's overall influence in such affairs means that ritual and magickal practice should be dispensed with, miss the whole point of the subject. Ritual and belief in its power increases the suggestibility of the ritualist, but if he dispenses altogether with the ritual element something is automatically missing from his consciousness which reduces the suggestibility factor. Thus his chances of succeeding in acquiring what he desires is also reduced. Ritual may seem "nonsense" to sceptics, but it really is a most *practical* psychological device. And in this age of ever increasing psychological confusion and isolation the need for magickal ritual is greater than ever.

The meaning and purpose of chants, spells and rituals is pretty much the same thing. It is difficult to separate them. They are all part of the same process, ie. the use of thoughts, words and actions in changing one's circumstances. "Enchantments", "Charms" and "Incantations" also mean much the same thing. Even in

prayer, traditionally divorced from the practice of magick in most people's eyes, and yet a very real part of the magickal world in usage, we deal with forces of the Inner Mind and external supernatural agencies. For what else is prayer but an affirmation of a thought, a desire for a thing sought?

Chant to Win in Gambling

Having now defined our subject let us progress to the practical uses for which it can be employed. Let us first take a chant that will appeal to many readers, a chant for winning in gambling. Before buying a lottery ticket, or placing a bet, or any other activity totally dependent upon the forces of chance performing this magickal formula, is well worth the reader's effort. Light some Frankincense, incense and a green candle and then close your eyes and see *exactly what it is that you want*, ie. see yourself being told that you have the winning ticket worth £100, or whatever sum of money is involved, or picture yourself jumping for joy that the horse you have placed your bet on has outrun all the odds. Simply hold in your mind's eye an exact image of the happy, desirable outcome to the gamble you are about to make. Now chant three times the following:

"Gods and Goddesses of Chance Smile Down
on Me,
Spin Thine Wheel of Fortune
With Thee I Shall Win, I Know.
Let The Gold and Sliver Begin to Flow
Into My Hands, it Will Not Stop
Until I've Gathered All the Crop".

Close your eyes again and visualise the happy outcome you seek. We would suggest that you perform this chant on the night before you intend to make your gamble. It

can be any night although we tend to feel Wednesday or Thursday nights are the most favourable. But this is not quite so important where this particular chant is required so don't worry if these nights are not convenient for your plans.

"Green" Visualatory Chant for Riches

This is a relatively uncomplicated chant, not requiring any candles, herbs, etc. which are often required for most magickal workings. All you do is sit and relax and imagine a *beautiful, brilliant ray of GREEN light shining down upon you*. Try and actually *breathe in* this light. Imagine it circulating within you. Now before you chant visualise the kind of riches you want, ie. a good income, a new home and/or car, an unexpected job promotion, or whatever it is that you seek in the way of riches. The more specific your desire the better the chances of success. Having visualised for a few minutes now chant eight times over:

"O Powerful Green Light
Command The Forces of
The North to Work With Me,
To Bring forth Riches and Abundance,
Let Thine Radiant Force Flow Through Me,
So Mote this Be!"

Now picture the green light dissolving. For best effects perform this chant for eight consecutive days or nights.

Voodoo Money Spell

This is very simple. Each time before you go out shopping, or pay your rent, or some other activity that involves spending money do the following. Place the money you intend to spend before you. Put some tiny

drops of green coloured "Money Drawing" oil on the money and concentrating on the money say seven times:

"Money, Money, Whom Goest Away
Come Back Manyfold Another Day"

Now close your eyes and believe with all of your heart that the money will come back to you in multiplied form. This is an old spell very popular amongst Voodooists. The "Money Drawing" oil, and materials required for other spells and rituals given in this booklet, can be obtained from the occult shops listed at the end. One will note the use of the colour *green* for these chants and spells; green is the traditional colour used by Occultists and Witches in money matters. Green is the colour of the rich and abundant earth and is also the colour of paper money; pound notes and dollar bills are green.

Voodoo Luck Spell

A similar Voodoo spell, this time for luck in gambling, is to rub "Lucky Gambler" oil on the palms of the hands and say as you do so:

"Lucky Oil Do Your Work
So That I Shall Win First".

Repeat seven times believing with all your heart that your luck is going to be in. This is a particularly good spell to use before playing a card game, placing a bet, playing bingo, roulette etc.

Voodoo Subjugation Spell

This is a good one for subduing a person who is trying to get the better of you, or making your life difficult in some way. Write on paper the name of the person to be subdued *seven times*. Now place on it some "Conquering Oil" and whilst doing this read three times Psalm 65

from the Authorised King James' Version of the Bible. Now burn the paper and think of your desire as you do so.

Peace in the Home Ritual

Prepare tea made from a Valerian Root herb and drink same. The remainder of the tea should be lightly sprinkled throughout the house and as you do so say over and over again until you finish:

"Peace Be Here, Peace Be Here
Tranquility, Tranquility Everywhere".

Perform this ritual on a Wednesday for best effect.

Spell for Increasing Mental Perception and Concentration

This one requires no oils or herbs. It should be done on the third night before a full moon. Look at the bright disc of the moon from a window and say:

"O Sacred Luna, O So Bright
Open My Mind, Soul and Sight
Let a Flame of Brilliance Glow
So that All Shall be Clear and All I Shall Know".

Now sit and close your eyes for a moment. Then read some light material – nothing heavy – for fifteen minutes. Stand up and look at the moon again and say: "Mistress of The Night, I Thank Thee".

Ritual to Bind a Love

Magick has been used from time immemorial to intervene in affairs of the heart. Here is a well-known, tried and tested magickal ritual for making someone love you and remain true to you. First place a photograph of the person to be spellbound in front of you and let your thoughts dwell on him/her. Now take a length of red

ribbon or yarn to which you will tie a different knot once a day, over a seven day period. The first knot should be in the middle of the yarn on the first day; the second knot a little to the right of the first; the third knot to the left of the first; fourth knot to the right of the second; fifth knot to the left of the third; sixth knot to near the end of the material on the right; and finally the seventh knot to near the left end of the material. As you tie each knot speak these words:

“With this Knot I Tie Your
Love and Bind It Firmly to Mine.
You Will Not be Able to
Break It or Loosen it.
Your Love Will be Totally
Mine and Mine Will be Yours.
This Knot Will Act as
A Bond Between
Us Forever and Nothing or
Anyone Will Ever be
Able to Untie It.”

After the seventh day hide the knotted material away in a secret place. For best results begin the ritual on the full moon.

Herbal Love Spell

Obtain some “St John’s Wort” herb and strew it over a fire and say:

“It is Not The Herb That I Now Burn
But the Heart of(person’s name) I
Mean to Turn
Ere He Bend to Me in Soul and Mind”.

This spell needs only to be cast once, but in difficult cases perform every day until the desired result is secured.

Another simple formula involving the "St John's Wort" herb is to place a small bag of it, pierced by a pin, over one's bed. That night, or the next night, one will see a vision or have a dream of one's future mate.

Divinitary Love Formula

A traditional formula for ascertaining if the man on a woman's mind is going to be hers or not is the following: carry all day in a pocket or purse two lemon peels. One peel can be put in the purse the other in a pocket, or each peel in a separate pocket. At night before retiring to bed rub the legs, or sides of the bed with the peels thinking intently on what you seek to know. Place the peels under pillow and that night, if she is to have him, he will appear in a dream. If no dream of him comes he is not to be hers.

Sex Ritual for Acquiring Riches

If you are happy with the one you love, and there is no need to use spells to secure one another's affections, then you can harness the tremendous psychic energy generated in your sexual activity as a means of gaining power in the material world. What lovers do not want a better life, more luxuries? And what better and more pleasant way of acquiring them by that most powerful magickal force of all – Sex? Sex backed by a definite thought or desire is a mighty thing indeed, hence the wide and traditional uses of sex in magick for thousands of years. Occultists and Magicians from all times and all places have always recognised the enormous level of psychic power contained in the sex act. In the ritual that follows you can make the irresistible combination of magick and sex work real wonders for you. First you place four lit green candles in your bedroom. The female

places a coin in a green handkerchief and ties same around her right wrist. The lovers then copulate taking care not to look at each other, but looking only at the candles thinking of the fortune and riches that they seek. After copulation they walk in a counter-clockwise direction blowing out the candles. Before blowing out the last candle the male unties the handkerchief and drops the coin into the flame. End of ritual.

Aphrodisiac Magick

Another tradition of magickal belief and practice is the custom of feeding one's partner with certain foods imbued with aphrodisiac properties that will arouse his/her passions. The word "aphrodisiac" is derived from "Aphrodite", the Love Goddess of the Ancient Greeks whom the Romans called "Venus". Traditionally aphrodisiac foods are believed to exert a more potent effect if *the correct foods are served to the partner whose astrological sun sign agrees with the foods concerned*. Aphrodisiac foods are ruled by the stars and thus by appropriate compliance with the Laws of Astrology a lover can gain better effects from his or her actions. Here is a brief list of the most suitable aphrodisiac foods for the various astrological signs:

ARIES:	Cinnamon, pepper, chestnuts
TAURUS:	Grapes, sage
GEMINI:	Carrots, fennel
CANCER:	Garlic, peppermint
LEO:	Almonds, celery seed
VIRGO:	Apples, thyme
LIBRA:	Parsley, figs, marjoram
SCORPIO:	Ginger, mustard, onions
SAGITTARIUS:	Sesame seed, nutmeg

CAPRICORN: Dates, wintergreen
AQUARIUS: Bananas, rye
PISCES: Mint, oranges.

Counter-Black Magick Spell

Most people have heard about the practises and effects of what is termed "Black Magick". Unfortunately, it is this aspect of magickal philosophy and practice that frightens most folk away from attempting to better their lives with spells and rituals. However, if one has misgivings about Black Magick, and undoubtedly many of the practises of Black Magick, are evil and hideous, *one should know how to deal with Black Magick if you suspect that somebody is using it against you.* This is only common sense. Ascertaining whether or not you are under the influence of some evil force is not difficult; the effects of Black Magic manifest themselves in a sudden, inexplicable run of bad luck; accidents; sudden illness; out of character depressive moods. If you think you are the victim of an evil spell you should analyze your thoughts and feelings very carefully. Are the negative things you feel really your own or have they been planted in you by someone else? Do not rush into any action that may harm your self-interests. Try to be calm. Watch your temper. Take life easy. Avoid too many commitments. Avoid driving if you can: use public transport. You may decide to consult an occultist to help you. Be careful if you do – too many occultists who claim to be able to remove curses are more interested in your money than in helping you regain peace of mind. Some are genuine, but far too many are charlatans. You can get better results by performing

your own Counter-Black Magick spell. Beginning on the first night of a waning moon, that is the period immediately following a Full Moon which lasts for about 13 nights, light a black candle and say nine times:

“Let This Candle Be Her/His Candle. This Burning, Her Burning. This Curse, Her Curse”.

If you know who it is who placed the curse on you you can visualize her/him suffering greatly from the consequences of his evil deeds. You can use the same candle every night for the duration of the waning moon. Midnight is the best time, but it can be earlier if you wish.

Lemon Evil-Trapping Ritual

We saw earlier how the peels of a lemon can be used to divine future love. In this ritual a lemon is used to symbolically capture an evil spell and dissolve it. Here is what you do. Undress and cover your nudity with only a robe/dressing gown. Place a cup of salt and an athame (a special witch's knife, available from the occult suppliers to be listed shortly) on a table to serve as an altar. Light two blue candles and “Protection” incense. Anoint your brow, throat and heart with a special oil also known as “Protection”. At the centre of your altar cut the lemon into four *round* slices with your athame. Now speak these words:

“I Command the Evil Against Me to Congre-
gate
Within This Lemon, That's Its Fate
Sour Evil to Sour Fruit

Bound to This Lemon Forever More.
The Evil Against Me That's Its Store.
The Evil in The Lemon Now I See
And as I Will, So Mote It Be!"

Now sprinkle lots of salt on the lemon and say:

"Destroy, O Salt of Purity, This Evil!
Vanquish That Which Sought to Harm Me!
As I Will, So Mote It Be!"

Leave lemon on altar for a few weeks to see if it dries out; if it turns to mildew then that's a sure sign that the evil has not been destroyed. Burn the lemon and do the ritual again with a new lemon.

To Turn Away Evil Charm

This can be used in conjunction with the previous ritual, or used by itself. Write on a small piece of parchment the following magickal formula, from an ancient German grimoire:

Fold parchment and carry on your person.

Fortune-Attracting Charm

Another charm involving the writing of a magickal formula on parchment is this one to promote luck and fortune. On the first Thursday of a new moon write the following:

"Non Licet Ponare in Egarbona Quia Pretium Sanguinis".

Fold parchment so that the writing is concealed and carry on your person. Use this charm in conjunction with the spells given earlier for luck in gambling for assured success in your undertakings.

The Magick of Herbs

Herbs have always been a staple item in the magician's world of chants, spells and rituals. They have a long tradition of magickal powers, being used for all kinds of weird and wonderful purposes since the dawning of mankind. The historical record shows that they were a part of the magickal tradition amongst the Ancient Egyptians, Celts, Druids, Romans and Greeks. Here is a very brief listing of the more popular herbs together with details of their magickal properties:

BASIL: An all-purpose herb; associated with fortune, protection and romance. Place small amounts in each room of house for peace, protection and harmony.

BETHEL NUT: Chewing this herb stimulates the mental processes and awakens spiritual powers.

DRAGON'S BLOOD: Used for breaking evil curses. Burn for seven consecutive nights at midnight.

EUROPEAN JOHN THE CONQUEROR: This strangely named root is recommended to be carried next to money in one's purse or pocket.

HIGH JOHN THE CONQUEROR: Carry for mental perception; clarity of mind; overcoming depression.

LESSER PERIWINKLE: Eaten by man and woman together it causes love and passion.

LAVENDER: Place under your pillow and think about a wish dear to your heart. If you dream about the wish upon sleeping it will come to fruition. No dream about the wish indicates that it will never come to pass.

FINGER GRASS: Sometimes called "Five Finger Grass" this potent herb is associated with protection and keeping away evil. Hung over bed it assures restful sleep.

MAGNOLIA: Magnolia leaves spread beneath bed mattress arouses passion in lovers.

ORRIS ROOT: Sprinkle on the clothes of person you desire. He or she will then feel drawn to you.

SANG ROOT: Used by the Chinese to ward off evil.

WAAHOO BARK: Employed to break curse placed on another person. Make a tea with it and rub it on forehead of afflicted person saying seven times the word "Waahoo" as you do so. Another version of this formula is to boil it in a quart of water for ten minutes and then sponge the forehead of the afflicted person whilst repeating "Waahoo" nine times.

RECOMMENDED BOOKS FOR FURTHER STUDY

So many occult books have appeared on the market in recent years that it can be quite baffling trying to choose what to buy and what not to buy. However, we can recommend the following books because they are (a)

The first book we recommended is *"How to Tap the Magic Power in Spells, Incantations, Prayers and Psalms"* by Geoffrey Samson, an extremely practical and simple guide to getting quick and effective results from the use of magick and mind power. Many of the formulae given require only the use of ordinary candles and no special incenses and materials normally required for working magick. Another good book is *"Winning with Witchcraft"* by Jean Williams which is full of practical advice and spells for getting whatever you want from life quickly and effectively; Definitely the best introductory book to witchcraft there is on the market today. Another book by Miss Williams which is a must for everyone interested in love and sex magick (. . . and who isn't) is *"A Witch's Guide to Love and Lust"*, which is full of spells and magickal formulae for love problems and desires of every kind. And perhaps the best volume of all is *"The Master Grimoire of Magickal Rites and Ceremonies"* by Nathan Elkana, a work full of *extremely* potent magick. In this author's view definitely the best available volume on magick there is. All books mentioned are available by mail order from Finbarr Books.

Although my book is called "Winning With Witchcraft" it is not a book for witches. Fully fledged witches will not find anything really new in its pages and indeed they may disapprove of many of the things written in it. With witchcraft you can forget about being a loser in love, in money, or anything else. By using witchcraft I show how you can actually take control of the "forces of chance" and make everything you touch seemingly turn to gold. You will be able to play a bingo game, place a bet, enter any contest, and know that you will win. You can have any man or woman you want, or any luxury you choose. With witchcraft these things become automatic when you use the appropriate spells or rituals to obtain them. I can say all this with absolute confidence for this has been my experience from practising witchcraft. I have benefitted handsomely from witchcraft and I only seek the pleasure of sharing my knowledge with you. Witchcraft, I believe, should not be the jealously guarded secret of a selfish few, but should be made available to all who seek a better and more fulfilling life.
