

**TF 759 MP BN SITREP
14 APRIL04**

1. **UNIT:** TF 759 Military Police Battalion.

2. **COMMANDER'S UPDATE.** Status is **GREEN**. TF 759 with five (5) GS MP Companies (**32/571/984/272/630** MP COs), two (2) ILO FA Companies (**109/112**), one (1) ILO FA Platoon (**1/107**), two (2) GS MP Detachments (**143/415** MP Det), and (1) OPCON MP Company (**214** MP CO). The TF is focused on MP Combat Operations, Police Training, Police Station Monitoring, Personal Security, Traffic Police, the River Patrol Station, support to the MEK, and the Criminal Investigation Laboratory. The TF is conducting continual Military Police training operations for ILO companies with the use of SMEs. The TF conducts MMSO, Police Intelligence Operations, and Area Security with a primary focus on reducing criminal and terrorist threats in our respective AORs. The 415th Military Police Detachment, 272 MP Company, and 630 MP Company's main focus is the oversight of the Iraqi Transition Integration Program and the Initial Recruit Program at the Police Academy. The 214th MP Company is OPCON to the battalion IOT conduct the 8-week Initial Recruit Course.

There was **0 US casualties** and no confirmed enemy dead. There was 1 engagement with enemy forces, which was an IED attack.

131844DAPR04 - MB MB4130578488 (ZONE 41) - IED EXPLOSION:

143rd MP DET CDR (Big Sky 6) reported an IED explosion. A three (3) vehicle convoy was hit by an unknown IED that was located on the South West side of the road. The IED detonated at vehicle #2. The convoy continued 100m and then assessed injuries and damages. No serious injuries were observed at that time and vehicles were damaged but thought to be self-recoverable. Convoy continued to Cuervo for evaluation, at MB 414778, convoy halted to reobserve damages to vehicles due to flat tires on Vehicle's #2 and #3. Enforcer Base was called, requesting recovery assets sent to location. Damage occurred to all three vehicles, and one M249 SAW. Detachment personnel stopped and

searched 4 personnel and one cart that came from blast direction. Nothing suspicious found. Recovery assets with additional security teams arrived and changed all flat tires. A patrol from the 1165th MP CO, 168 MP BN, arrived and assisted with security. Once tires were changed, convoy proceeded to Camp Cuervo. Line of March was as follows:

Vehicle #1: Driver SPC Sichelstiel, Gunner SPC Gallagher, Team Leader SGT Wallace right rear, and Commander CPT Traynham right front.

Vehicle #2: Driver SPC Miller, Team Leader SGT Richards, Gunner SGT Jensen, Squad Leader SSG Klumb right rear and Det NCOIC MSG McLane, left rear.

Vehicle #3: Driver SPC Routzhan, Team Leader SGT Biesemeyer, Gunner SPC Elder, and Passenger, SSG Pedersen, Right Rear.

All personnel were assessed by medics at HQ TF 759 MP. SSG Klumb, SPC Elder and SGT Jensen were taken to E CO 115 FSB for further assessment, and were RTD.

Damage was found on vehicle #1: Hole from shrapnel in tail gate and vehicle #2: rear two tires flat, M249 SAW feed tray destroyed, and vehicle #3, front right tire flat.

6. **ONGOING OPERATIONS** TF 759 continues to conduct IP station protection/defense IOT protect IP station personnel and assets from Mahdi Army and other insurgent forces at (5) five key stations will revert to station monitoring/oversight at remaining stations.

CDR'S ISSUES.

MP Issues:

#1 SHORTAGE OF M1114s: The TF needs 77 additional up-armored HMMWV to replace M1025/1026's.

#2 SHORTAGES OF CLASS IX PARTS: The flow of Class IX parts to the TF is very slow. Some parts have been on back order for months.

#3 TRAIN-UP OF ILO MPS: ILO companies will receive equipment and perform missions they are unfamiliar with, which will require much more intensive training than a standard MP company.

IP Issues:

#1 DCELL OVERCROWDING: The direct cause of detention cell overcrowding is judges taking up to 10 days to hear cases. The 24-hour guideline to see a suspect is not a priority for the courts and is forcing the IPS to hold prisoners for too long in station cells, which are only meant for short detention time. Miscommunication of policy to ICS staff at Rusafa Isla Hiya regarding management of bed space and refusing to take prisoners ordered by the court has also resulted in the overcrowding of D-cells.

#2 IP BADGES: There is a back log of approximately 2000 badge request for IPs. The current system only allows for 100 badges issued per week, at this rate we will not correct the back log issue.

#3 GLOCKS: The one day Glock training has been suspended because of the shortage of Glock pistols. This affects the availability of Ips able to attend the TIPS course, as TIPS training requires attendees to have in their possession an assigned Glock weapon.
